FREEWAY AIRPORT CROSS-COUNTRY CHECKLIST 5/2005

TO DO WELL IN ADVANCE OF THE PLANNED FLIGHT:

- 1. Check chart currency
- 2. Locate departure and destination airports
- 3. Locate special use airspace and obstructions along route
- 4. Locate useful navigation aids
- 5. Draw true course lines and determine true course
- 6. Determine course check points and distances
- 7. Determine magnetic variation
- 8. Determine bearings or radials and frequencies of navigation aids which you intend to use
- 9. Determine airport frequencies, runway lengths and takeoff and landing distance information and any other pertinent information from the A.F.D.
- 10. Obtain airport diagram

DO BEFORE COMING TO THE AIRPORT OR 2 HOURS BEFORE SCHEDULED FLIGHT:

- 11. Obtain a complete weather briefing
- 12. Determine cruise altitude
- 13. Determine pressure altitude and temperature for cruise
- 14. Compute fuel, time, and distance to climb
- 15. Determine true airspeed and GPH for cruise (RPM for cruise)
- 16. Determine ground speed, wind correction angle for cruise
- 17. Determine magnetic course and heading
- 18. Determine time between check points, and total time enroute
- 19. Determine fuel requirements for entire flight
- 20. Fill out and file FAA flight plan
- 21. Determine weight and balance data
