FLIGHT TIME REQUIREMENTS Private Pilot FAR part 141

A. 20 hrs. of **Dual** to include

- 1) 3 hrs. of x-country
- 2) 3 hrs. of night, including
 - a) One x-country flight of over 100 NM total distance
 - b) 10 takeoffs and landings
- 3) 3 hrs. of instrument flight training
- 4) 3 hrs. in prep. for the practical test within 60 days

B. 5 hrs. of Solo flight time including

- 1) One Solo x-country flight of at least 100 NM with landings at a minimum of three points and with one leg of the flight a straight line distance of 50 NM between takeoff and landing locations. [X-C Flights must go more than 50NM from original departure point with a landing.]
- 2) Three takeoffs and landings to a full stop at an airport with a operating control tower.

C. 35 hrs. Total Flight Time.

FLIGHT TIME REQUIREMENTS FAR part 61

A. 20 hrs. of **Dual** to include:

- 1) 3 hrs. X-C Dual
- 2) 3 hrs. of night, including
 - a) One X-C flight of over 100nm total distance
 - b) 10 takeoffs and landings
- 3) 3 hrs. of instrument flight training

B. 10 hrs. of **Solo** flight time including:
